

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-101

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1 permit contracting of services without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or performance of services; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen which affects the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Phillipsburg, to wit, emergency repair work being performed on the headworks at the waste water treatment plant; and;

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Town's professionals and Mayor, it is necessary to immediately provide for the necessary repairs to the impacted areas to ensure that the health, safety and welfare of the public is not compromised; and

WHEREAS, Spectraserv, Inc has submitted a proposal to perform the services necessary to repair the headworks; and

WHEREAS, said work is for the amount NOT TO EXCEED \$95,070.00.

WHEREAS, Remington & Vernick Engineering has submitted correspondence dated June 15, 2026, opining that an emergency exists such that the normal procurement process pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law can not be complied with as such compliance would result in unnecessary delay and continued harm to the public; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated work being authorized to the extent now know is as follows:.

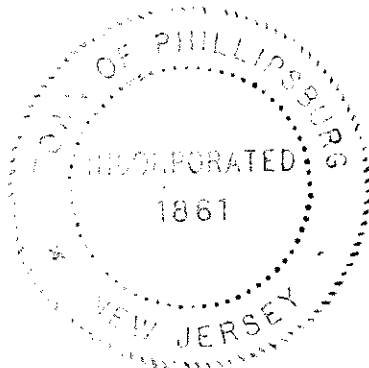
1. Spectraserve, Inc. Remove & Install or replace gate, By-pass pumping, removal of failed sluice gate, and cleaning of wet well.

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available as evidenced by the attached Certification of Funds.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, that the Town Council declares an emergency to exist as detailed above for which emergency services are needed and authorizes the retention of and payments to the above mentioned company for services detailed hereinabove.
